Toxins: Coming to a Picnic Near You

Did you know that one of America's greenest assets could be poisoning our children? According to National Geographic's Green Guide, 75 percent of American households use pesticides on their lawns-the toxic kind that pose threats to human health and wildlife. Of 103.9 million households with lawns, more than half use insecticides; 40 million use herbicides and 14 million use fungicides. These conventional pesticides have killed more birds than West Nile virus and resulted in the accidental poisonings of children.

The good news? There are safer alternatives. Several least-toxic remedies can be made from everyday household ingredients or bought commercially. But it's not just the products that need to be replaced. The National Wildlife Federation and the National Audubon Society are spearheading campaigns to change our habits and the way Americans think about lawn care.
