FOUR PILLARS ANALYSIS

The Chinese utilize an astrological system known as the Four Pillars. This analysis is based on a person's date and time of birth, and, the city where born. Reading from right to left, a chart is created with "Pillars" known as the Year, Month, Day and Hour. Each pillar has a Heavenly Stem and an Earthly Branch. This system is based on the Chinese Five Element theory of the elements: Water, Wood, Fire, Earth and Metal.

Your personality type will be one of the five elements, and, will be considered Strong, Gentle, or Extremely Gentle. This does not reflect your physical abilities; rather, it reflects the interaction of all the elements within your chart. You will notice that there are animals within the chart, also. The animal under your Year pillar is your animal type. This is useful to read information about your type and, if you are born near the beginning of the year, you may have thought it was different based on the Chinese Restaurant Placemat Method! The Solar Chinese New Year begins near February 4, so those born in January are actually in the previous year.

In regard to your personal element, certain other elements are found to be supportive to you. These elements are listed, along with the colors, shapes and locales that would be most supportive to you. Additionally, your "Luck Pillars" are analyzed to see what current five-year luck time you are in. If you are in a time where your supportive elements are present, it indicates that these should be "luckier" times for you. If you do not currently have these present, elements to support you through that time period are recommended.

Additionally, your "best" directions are listed. These are directions that also help support you. You can either face them when sitting in a chair or at a desk, or, have the directions behind your head when sleeping. You might also consider them when you have to give a speech, or, are negotiating with someone!

Finally, the inter-relationships of all the elements in your chart create certain "Heavenly Influences" known as the Ten Gods Analysis. This provides information about how you live your life and what is most compatible for you.

This information should help you surround yourself with positive elements, directions, colors and shapes. Further analysis is available, particularly in locating an appropriate home or office, or, understanding a relationship. With best wishes for good chi!

Sheng Chi:	East - This is your direction to face for energizing yourself, and, to bring good fortune to your business, personal life and financial affairs. It is ideal for your bedroom, anywhere you want to spend a lot of time in, or, as a direction to face.

Fire people are leaders, charismatic, self-driven and passionate. If things get dull, they will ignite a new creation. They are always looking for new things and can be quite adventurous. Change is common, and they often leap before looking. This creates successful ventures and also problems. Fire people like being the center of attention. They are good speakers but can be difficult listeners. They think and act fast. They can be flamboyant, passionate and make life exciting. This excitement/passion needs to be kept in check for balance and patience.

TEN GODS/HEAVENLY INFLUENCES

Luck Pillars: On your 47th birthday, you entered a Yang Metal five year period (this will last until your 52nd birthday). This is known as the Zheng Cai, based upon the ten personality possibilities of the self element. This will be a time where you will have the capability to develop a good career with a steady flow of income. Careful planning and organizing will benefit you in this time. This influence has not been present in your birth chart prior to this time, and would be a good time to focus on this capability.

Upon turning 52, you will enter a five year time period of Yin Water. This will be a time that emphasizes courage and aggressiveness. It reflects using power to achieve, and often it is done in an insensitive way, particularly during times of pressure or stress. You could have a tendency to want to break the rules and pave your own way. This influence is noted in your birth chart, and may not be an unfamiliar way of life. However, during the mentioned time period, it will be especially emphasized.

Other influences noted in your birth chart:

Pian Yin – Yin Wood: You have an ability to learn new things easily. There may be occasions when you have difficulties in relationships, may lack patience, and, you may be susceptible to jealousy. Try to avoid “conditional love” with others, and this will help you to achieve your successes.

WOOD SHEEP

This is a thoughtful, good-humored Sheep, with leisurely ways, but mindful of other people's wishes. He is sentimental and strives to please, with Wood as his element he will be prevented from being too flippant. His nature will be steadier and more generous, and he will have high moral principals.

This loving Sheep will have complete trust in those he believes in. He will put his life in their hands with the simple faith of a child. Even though he is aware of his intrinsic worth, this Sheep allows others to take advantage of him. He capitulates too readily when harassed and makes unwise sacrifices for the sake of "keeping the peace".
